


EDUCATION ADVICE

Stay focused, do your best.



In 1950, roughly 431,000 people earned Bachelor's Degrees. Today, roughly 1,895,000 people earned Bachelor's Degrees.




GENERAL LIFE ADVICE


FAITH ADVICE
